To help cover the cost of our services, we ask every guest family for a modest \$50 per night rent. However, we serve all families regardless of their ability to pay. In a typical year, we waive as much or more rent revenue as we receive. This revenue category includes self-paid service fees as well as those paid fully or partially by third parties on behalf of the guests. Third parties include: American Cancer Society, Reno Cancer Center, Bakersfield Firefighters Burn Foundation, Shriners Hospital for Children - Northern California, UC Davis Medical Center, and various county children's services.






